Applications must be holders of PhD degree in Fisheries and Aquaculture Management and Animal Nutrition/Animal Production or equivalent. They should have research experience with at least 24 publications points of which 16 should be from refereed journals. They should show evidence of continuing research activity.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach at both undergraduate and or postgraduate students, supervise research projects and undertake further research in their areas of specialization.
