In November 2012, Ford Foundation President Luis A. Ubiñas gave a public lecture in University of Nairobi's Taifa Hall. The well attended public lecture was part of the Foundation's 50th anniversary in Eastern Africa celebrations and it is fitting that it was held in Taifa Hall, famous as a place of rich history with intellectual debates dating back to close to 40 years ago.

While reflecting on the five decades of progress, opportunities and challenges in Eastern Africa President Ubiñas commended Kenya for the great strides the country has made since independence. He said that every Kenyan, young or old has a special responsibility to make this country better and called upon the youth to take their rightful role as leaders rather than being used as pawns by politicians.
